

Dear saints,

The Lord has granted us a wonderful and profitable 2019 Spring quarter at UC Davis! The following report is intended to encourage more saints to pray for the Lord's move on the campus.

**A. Joint Coordination (students, grads and serving ones) for Christians on Campus club:**

- Students and some serving ones met every Monday evening at 6 PM for dinner, prayer and fellowship in a home
- Consistently had 7-11 students at every meeting
- This quarter particularly there has been a lot more student participation and burden for various club activities.
  - i. Bible reading challenges
  - ii. Planning Spring break trip to Reno, Alpha House, Redding and Chico
  - iii. Planning Bon-fire, dumpling nights, etc.
- Students formed small groups and took up various responsibilities on their own
- Established defined roles for new club officers,
  - i. Selected new ones through an interviewing process.
  - ii. This will help with the continuation of the club for future school year.
- Plan to continue coordination during the summer to come together and pray for the next quarter.
- Planning a Bible or ministry reading schedule for the summer months

**B. Spring Bible Study - Ephesians**

- The students formed into small groups that met at various times during the week to read the selected portion in Ephesians
- Each Wednesday, the large group would come together at 6PM on the campus for sharing what they enjoyed during the small group time
- The fellowship and overflow from each large Bible Study has been more enjoyable and more mutual after the students started to take the lead in the Bible study.
- There's a dramatic increase in consistent average attendance to the large group Bible Study from 6 students last school year to 13 students this school year.
- Starting in the middle of the 2019 Spring Quarter, the students really took ownership of the Bible study by taking the lead to begin each session and end each session.
- The combination of the large group Bible study plus the small group gatherings has really become a gateway for the new ones to enter into the Christians of Campus community.
  - i. Small groups help establish relationship with new ones thus retaining them.

**C. Spring NorCal College Conference (Mt. Gilead)**

- Total attendance from NorCal campuses: 270
- Davis attendance: 25 (17 students, 5 serving, 3 working)
- Subject: God's Heart's Desire and His Eternal Purpose in Genesis 1 & 2
- Blending with other localities during cabin times
- Mutual learning and encouragement from the "campus reporting" (both all together and in small groups)

**D. Spring Break Trip (Reno, Alpha House, Redding, Chico)**

- One week trip to Reno, Lake Tahoe, Alpha House, Redding and Chico!
- Enjoyable time hiking at the Goodwin ranch outside of Reno
- Blending in the homes of the saints and Lord's table meeting in Reno
- One new contact was saved and baptized as a result of his enjoyment on this trip

- Total of 21 going from Davis (including FTTA trainees supporting Davis)
